The Edwin O. Reischauer Institute of Japanese Studies will provide small grants (maximum \$500) to help cover word-processing, binding, or other costs for the final draft of the dissertation to qualified Harvard doctoral candidates in the field of Japanese studies in the humanities or social sciences.

Application process: Applicants are responsible for submitting a proposal consisting of the following:

1. Cover letter indicating
 - a. Date PhD degree to be awarded
 - b. Academic department and field of study
 - c. Name(s) of dissertation advisor(s)
 - d. Dissertation title
 - e. Itemized budget

2. Thesis abstract (1 page)

3. Curriculum vitae -- include:
 - Citizenship
 - Social Security number
 - Harvard ID number
 - Current/permanent address, tel. number(s), email address
