

COURSES FOR STUDENTS INTERESTED IN EXPLORING GOVERNMENT:

- Government has five subfields in the concentration, and though students do not have to declare just one, they do have to take one course in each of the subfields:
 - Political Methodology
 - Political Theory
 - American Government
 - International Relations
 - Comparative Government

First Year and Third Term

- Students should take an introductory course in a Government subfield which interests them. Some suggestions include:
 - Political Theory: **Government 10**
 - Comparative Government: **Government 20**
 - American Government: **Government 30**
 - International Relations: **Historical Study A-12**, **International Conflict and Cooperation in the Modern World**, or **Quantitative Reasoning 38**, **The Strategy of International Politics**
 - Political Methodology: **Government 1001**, **Introduction to Quantitative Methods in Political Science**
- Potential concentrators may also want to enroll in any course past the introductory level that interests them in the Government department as they all will count as requirements toward the concentration.
