

**COURSES FOR STUDENTS INTERESTED IN EXPLORING ROMANCE LANGUAGES AND LITERATURES:**

**Romance Languages and Literatures**

- Has ten tracks:
  - French and Francophone Literature or French and Francophone Studies
  - Hispanic Literature or Hispanic Studies
  - Italian Literature or Italian Studies
  - Latin American Studies
  - Portuguese and Brazilian Literature or Portuguese and Brazilian Studies
  - Romance Studies

**First Year**

- First years should begin to take language classes at the appropriate level as determined by the Harvard placement tests.

**Third Term**

- By spring of the sophomore year, students should be enrolled in language classes at the **40 or 50 levels**, or have scored a 750 or higher on the Harvard placement test.
- Students at an advanced language level may want to begin taking the **70-level** language courses. These courses are good introductory courses to literature and are required in almost all the Romance Language tracks.
