Application requirements:

- 1-Completed CARAT application form at <https://asperin.fas.harvard.edu/carat/>
- 2-Official transcript copy
- 3-Current resume
- 4-Detailed description of the language program
- 5-Explanation of why you are not taking this course at Harvard
- 6-Letter of acceptance by the institution offering the language program
- 7-Brief statement from your Harvard faculty advisor as to why this language is necessary for your course of study.
