## Summer Masters Thesis Grant

The Committee on African Studies offers summer travel grants to assist Harvard graduate students doing masters thesis research on Africa. These grants are for research and travel only in Sub-Saharan Africa. Students must be returning to Harvard the following year. Grants require a minimum stay of **six weeks** in Africa. Graduate students in all Harvard schools whose research focuses on Sub-Saharan Africa are eligible to apply. Grants cover only partial expenses, and students should also apply elsewhere for additional funds.

Applications for summer 2010 masters thesis research grants are due by **3:00 pm, Friday, February 12, 2010 at the Committee on African Studies, Room S403, 1730 Cambridge St., CGIS.**
