ONE half-course in the literature of a foreign language relevant to the student's studies, with reading assignments in the original language, to be completed by the end of the junior year. The grade received must be a B- or higher.

ONE half-course in literature that considers materials from a comparative and specifically postcolonial perspective. Possible courses: Eng 166x or Eng 167p, or by petition a reasonable substitute.

ONE half-course on the history of the colonial and postcolonial world that considers materials from a comparative or transregional perspective. Possible courses: Hist 1895 or Hist 1916, or by petition a reasonable substitute.

THREE half-courses directly related to the student's primary region of focus, two of which must cover different eras as determined in consultation with the student's tutor and the COI Co-Chair.

ONE half-course related to a second region of focus.
