Professor Kamm is the author of *Creation and Abortion* (OUP, 1992); *Morality, Mortality, Vol. 1: Death and Whom to Save From It* (OUP, 1993); *Morality, Mortality, Vol. 2: Rights, Duties, and Status* (OUP, 1996); and, most recently, *Intricate Ethics* (OUP, 2007). She has also published many articles on normative ethical theory and practical ethics. She has held ACLS, AAUW, NEH, and Guggenheim fellowships and has been a Fellow of the Program in Ethics and the Professions at the Kennedy School, the Center for Human Values at Princeton, and the Center for Advanced Study at Stanford. She is a member of the editorial boards of *Philosophy & Public Affairs*, *Legal Theory*, *Bioethics*, and *Utilitas* and was a consultant on ethics to the World Health Organization.
