

REISCHAUER INSTITUTE UNDERGRADUATE SUMMER JAPANESE LANGUAGE GRANTS (2008)

The Reischauer Institute will award several grants to Harvard undergraduates in any concentration who plan to enroll in a summer Japanese language study program in Japan. The grant will provide funding towards tuition, travel, and living expenses. Preference will be given to those students whose concentrations either require or give credit for language study, or who plan a senior thesis project that makes use of the language to be studied. Grants are up to \$6,000.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

This is the website for the Harvard International Centers' Summer Research Travel Grants (SRTG) common application.
- 2) Under the heading "*Participating Centers and their SRTG descriptions*," refer to the summary description of the Reischauer Institute grants.
- 3) Follow each of the 6 steps outlined in "*Application Instructions*." You will be guided through the on-line "Common Application for Research and Travel" (CARAT) tool. Review the "*Summary Information about Funding Centers' Requirements*" as a checklist for the standard application materials & any supplemental application information you must provide in your application for this specific grant.
- 4) **Submit your completed application by Tuesday, February 26, 2008, 12:00 noon, to the Fellowships Office, Office of Career Services (OCS), 54 Dunster Street.**
- 5) Announcement of the Reischauer Institute awards will be made directly to the student by the Reischauer Institute by April 7, 2008.

Application instructions specific to the RI Undergraduate Summer Japanese language grant:

- Indicate the summer language program to be attended and schedule.
- Proposal should explain the student's degree of preparation for studying Japanese in Japan and how such an opportunity will fit into the student's overall course of study at Harvard.
- Applicant must include a budget [for airfare, internal travel, tuition, lodging, food]
- Applications must be supported by 2 letters of recommendation, one from a language instructor (if appropriate). Language instructor should complete the "Language instructor reference" sheet.
- You must inform the Institute if you receive any other awards for this proposal after you submit this application.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Tuesday, February 26, 2008, by 12:00 noon (in OCS Office, 54 Dunster St.)
